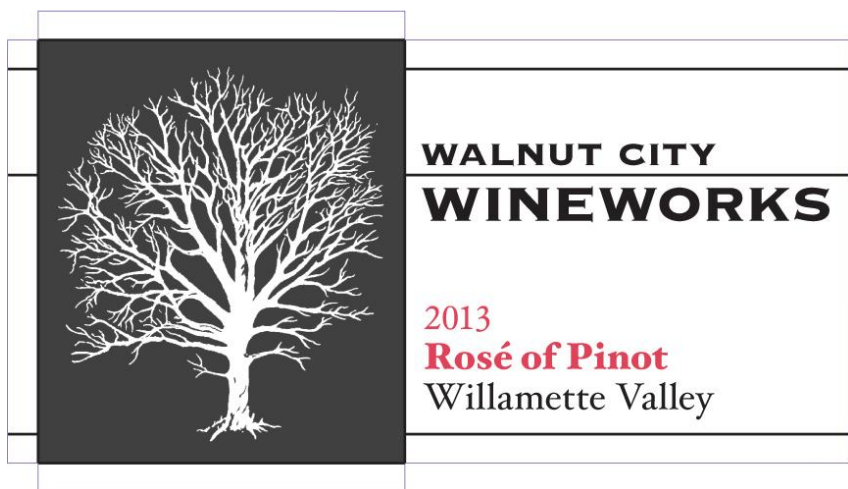

VINIFICATION: HAND HARVESTED GRAPES ARE WHOLE CLUSTER PRESSED AND THE JUICE COLD SETTLED OVERNIGHT. THE JUICE IS RACKED TO NEUTRAL BARRELS AND INOCULATED. FERMENTATION IS SLOW AND COOL TO ACCENTUATE FLORAL, FRUIT, AND CITRUS AROMAS. AFTER 4 MONTHS, THE WINE IS RACKED TO TANK, FILTERED, AND BOTTLED.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES: AROMAS OF CHERRY BLOSSOMS AND CITRUS PEEL ARE THE FIRST OUT OF THE GLASS FOLLOWED BY STRAWBERRY LEMONADE , TOAST WITH BUTTER AND JAM, TALC, AND THE MELLOW WOODY SMELL OF WALKING THROUGH A FRUIT ORCHARD ON A SUNNY DAY. A VERY DRY BUT FAIRLY ROUND AND JUICY PALATE ARE EXTENDED BY THE MOUTHWATERING ACIDITY. —
